

The Board will encourage and support the professional staff in their effort to investigate and develop new curricular ideas.

The Superintendent will lead curriculum development for the school system through the appointment of curriculum committees. Curriculum committees shall review existing curriculum and provide recommendations for improvements, including selection of new instructional materials, methods, and evaluation tools, as necessary.

The Superintendent will submit to the Board recommendations developed by the curriculum committees and the professional staff. The Board is encouraged to solicit community opinion while reviewing and evaluating curriculum recommendations. The School Board will make final decisions on curriculum change.

All teachers have professional obligations to the school program beyond regular classroom duties, including work on curriculum committees. It is expected that all teachers contribute to curriculum development.
