

ADMISSION OF RESIDENT STUDENTS**JFAA**

The District of residence of a student is defined by NH Law.

All new resident students, accompanied by parent(s)/guardian(s) when necessary, shall register at school as early as possible.

Children entering the District for the first time must have proof of physical examination, and immunization records, and the school must receive a copy of the child's birth certificate. Principals or their designees will meet with new children and parent(s)/guardian(s) to explain school programs.
