

The Stratham Board recognizes that at any given time there may be students in our schools who have serious allergies. While no school can provide a totally allergen-free environment, the District will take reasonable steps to work with staff, students and their parents/guardians to minimize the risks of severe allergic reactions at school.

The Board directs the Superintendent, building administrators and school nurses to develop and implement appropriate procedures to address student allergies. It is understood that these procedures may vary from school to school, since middle and high school students can be expected to take more responsibility for managing their allergies than students in the elementary grades.

Guidelines for the implementation of this policy at the elementary, middle, and high school levels may be provided upon request from the school administration.
