

STUDENT SUSPENSION

Prior to suspension of a student an investigation and a hearing shall be conducted by the principal. This hearing shall include at least:

1. notification of student that alleged violation is grounds for suspension,
2. specification of violation, in detail, and opportunity for student to respond.

The following infractions are to be considered as grounds for suspension; the list is intended to be illustrative, not exhaustive. The duration and place of suspension is to be determined by the administration. In each case of suspension, the administration will notify parents of grounds, duration and place of suspension.

1. Arson
2. Verbal or physical threatening behavior
3. Theft of property or receiving stolen property
4. Fighting
5. Destruction of property
6. Improper use of motor vehicle
7. Unexcused absences from homeroom, class, or supervised study
8. Refusal to identify one's self to staff member
9. Excessive trancies
10. Leaving school grounds without authorization
11. Unauthorized presence in gym and locker room areas
12. Grossly disrespectful conduct
13. Violation of the policy on smoking
14. Disrupting school activity
15. Throwing or projecting missiles of any kind, including snowballing
16. Repeated unexcused tardiness to homeroom, class, or assigned study
17. Possession and/or use of alcoholic beverages and/or drugs
18. Endangering safety and well-being of a member of the school community
19. Gambling
20. Unauthorized presence in restricted area of buildings or grounds.
