The SAU 16 Technology Standards for Educators and the SAU 16 Technology Standards for Administrators will guide educators and administrators in the development of individual professional development plans in the area of technology. Teachers should consult the SAU 16 Levels of Technology Integration Rubric to assess the level of technology integration in their classroom.
